


Accredited Healthcare Providers by CHI One of CHI's key roles is to accredit and classify healthcare providers to ensure the quality of services and patient safety.

The inpatient experience survey covers 6 domains, which are evaluated by the patients






Outpatient Experience

Outpatient Experience Domains Performance


The outpatient clinic patient experience survey includes 6 domains evaluated by patients.
